Brief statement of what happened:

Unequal Pay for Same Work
(Basketball Coach) as men. As a result
of negotiations with Board of Education, salaries for
1974-75 were adjusted to be nearly equal. However,
the 1975-76 ^{men's} coaching salaries exceed those for women
again, by a substantial difference (\$209.00)
This difference is not justified by effort, skill,
responsibility and location of work.
